Thanks to this highly operational exercise, our Air Forces are able to participate in complex operations such as the ones taking place in Afghanistan or Libya.

Since March, 19th, France has deployed its troops for the Unified Protector. Was there any consequence as far as the disposition of the exercise is concerned?

Yes indeed, the Air Forces deployed over Libya have been reconsidered on their disposition aspect. The French Air Force has nonetheless decided to maintain the Nato Tiger Meet 2011 for its real benefit and its high value-added. THE "JE NE SAIS QUOI" OF THE TIGER MEET



hat makes the Nato Tiger Meet such a unique event? This is the question we asked to Major Boris Pomirol, the deputy of the 1/12 "Cambresis" Squadron Chief of Operations. In the exercise, he organizes and Carries out the scenarios in the White Cell.

Besides some similarities, you can tell the Tiger Meet from the other combined exercises taking place in Europe, for its intense activities and its particularly high rhythm. Indeed, numerous COMAO (COMposite Air Operations), which are devices for different aircraft intended to carry out complex missions with various objectives. They are scheduled every afternoon for experienced and battledhardened pilots for the duration of the

exercise. In the morning, younger pilots are able to get a more basic training In order to improve their education.

According to Major Pomirol, the social and relational dimension is the utmost essential. Pilots know each other and meet each year. They do not need any time to adapt to each other, they can work together right away. Despite the fact that operational procedures are the same, each nation has its track. "No matter where they come from, F16 pilots share the same approach to the missions", the French pilot reckons.

Again this year, Nato Tiger Meet benefits from the great diversity of the 17 nations'skills while keeping a homogeneous achievement of the missions.
