The Recognition process detailed in EMAD R, Edition 2.0 has been followed and confidence and evidence has been gained that DSAÉ and DGA together as the French Military Aviation Authority can be recognised by LufABw regarding their airworthiness activities.

The MAA's conduct of regulatory assurance, as detailed in their MARQ Responses to Sub-Sections A, B, C and D, is considered to be suitable for their artefacts based on "EMAR (FR)" and "FRA".

The re-use of artefacts based on "FRA" regulations require additional verification of this artefacts within the German national framework.

DSAÉ and DGA conduct of regulatory assurance, as detailed in their MARQ responses to Sub-Sections A, B, C and D, are assessed being at a standard that artefacts without any product related focus, can be used by LufABw.




The Recognition Certificate is valid until 30 April 2021.

The Recognition Certificate will be reviewed for the first time on October 2020 unless any significant change to the Airworthiness Authorities or to the baseline of this recognition process occurs before that date.

The Recognition Partner undertake to inform the other Recognition Partners immediately of any significant changes to their Authority (Step 18 of EMAD R refers). Furthermore, an exchange of general information approximately at the middle of the recognition period is agreed.

The essential principle that recognition is a national responsibility is maintained, hence sovereign regulatory responsibility is not abdicated by issuance of this certificate.
