- 6. DSAÉ, where release is permissible, undertake to supply original / updated artefacts which have been identified as being required to support the airworthiness strategy of UK programmes, as identified by the MAA or a UK MoD Project Team.
- 7. DSAÉ undertakes to inform the MAA in a timely manner of any concerns they may have relating to the performance of any approved organization, the approval of which has been used, via Recognition, by the MAA.
