CERTIFICATE OF RECOGNITION

1. Recognition, in this case, is of an Authority by another Authority. To achieve the goal of regulating once and using the outcome many times, the recognition process guidelines detailed in EMAD R have been followed and confidence has been gained that DSAÉ's airworthiness assurance and regulatory approach is acceptable to DGAM.
2. DSAÉ's conduct of regulatory assurance is assessed as being at a standard by which the continuing airworthiness artefacts can be accepted by DGAM as described in Table 1.

Artefacts	Remarks
DSAÉ's approvals of maintenance and training organisations can be accepted by the recognising authority.	Approvals based on EMAR FR 145 and EMAR FR 147/66 only.
Audits and surveillance for the approvals of maintenance and training organisations may be conducted jointly.	Development of the process for conducting joint audits and surveillance is required.

Note: Spain has adopted the EDA EMARs standards in their national regulation under the terminology PERAM. Only the section A of the EMARs has been published in the PERAMs. Section B remains an internal document for the DGAM

3. The Recognition Certificate is valid until May 2020.
4. The Recognition Certificate will be reviewed for the first time on February 2019 unless any significant changes (Step 18 of EMAD R refers) to the Authorities occur before that date.
5. DSAÉ undertakes to inform DGAM immediately of any significant changes in accordance with Step 18 of EMAD R.
6. DSAÉ undertakes to supply approval certificates, audit reports, supporting documents, findings and subsequent closure action to DGAM in English for all initial approvals and on-going surveillance activity for approvals, accepted/to be accepted by DGAM.
7. DSAÉ undertakes to inform DGAM in a timely manner of any concerns they may have relating to the performance of a maintenance or training organization, the approvals of which has been adopted by DGAM.
8. The essential principle that Recognition is a national responsibility is maintained, hence sovereign regulatory responsibility is not abdicated by issuance of this Recognition Certificate.
9. The Recognition Partners' signatories below are duly authorised to make the agreements given above and do so in light of the EDA Steering Board decision dated 10 Nov 2008 in Ministerial formation.
