## CERTIFICATE OF RECOGNITION

- 3. This Recognition Certificate is valid 4 years from the date of signature mentioned on the cover page of the present document.
- 4. This Recognition Certificate will be reviewed for the first time at least 6 months before the end date of its validity unless any significant changes (Step 17 of EMAD R refers) to the Authorities occurs before that date.
- 5. **DSAÉ** undertakes to inform FLYGI immediately of any significant changes in accordance with Step 17 of EMAD R.
- 6. **DSAE** undertakes to supply approval certificates, audit reports, supporting documents, findings and subsequent closure action to FLYGI in English for all initial approvals and on-going surveillance activity for approvals, accepted/to be accepted by FLYGI.
- 7. **DSAÉ** undertakes to inform FLYGI in a timely manner of any concerns they may have relating to the performance of a maintenance or training organization, the approvals of which has been adopted by **FLYGI**.
- 8. The essential principle that recognition is a national responsibility is maintained; hence sovereign regulatory responsibility is not abdicated by issuance of this certificate.
