1. Holder of an outsourcing market for auditing activities, OSAC has proven its integrity and demonstrated its capacity to assure and perform audits, certification, and oversight activities in the state aviation continuing airworthiness frame and for the benefit of the DSAE. Therefore, OSAC fully complies with the criteria's required for a qualified entity as defined by the State aviation authority, DSAE.
2. As qualified entity, OSAC assures the possession of the greatest possible professional integrity and the greatest possible technical competence.
3. AS qualified entity, OSAC assures total independence from the state aviation regulated community, in particular from maintenance organisations, continuing airworthiness monitoring organisations and training organisations.
4. As qualified entity, OSAC assures freedom from any pressure and incentive, in particular of a financial type, which could affect its judgment and the results of its activities done on behalf of the DSAE, in particular from persons, or group of persons, who could be potentially affected by the results of the audit, certification or oversight activities.
5. As a qualified entity, OSAC assures to DSAE the employment of adequate staff, qualified, knowledgeable and experienced in certification, audits and oversight tasks, as well as the means required to perform adequately the technical and administrative tasks linked with the certification, approval and oversight process.
6. As a qualified entity for the DSAE, OSAC cannot issue certificates or legal approvals.
7. Its privilege is to act on behalf of the DSAE providing support that will enable DSAE to issue or renew approvals to the concerned organisation.
8. The frame of this privilege is limited to the state aviation continuing airworthiness field, in particular rules applicable to maintenance, training and continuing airworthiness management organisations. As an exemption aircraft airworthiness reviews are not included in this frame.
9. This Certificate is valid as long as OSAC will be able to hold an oversight capacity in French state aviation airworthiness.
10. This Certificate will be reviewed every 4 years and renewed if satisfactory.
