- 3. This Recognition Certificate is valid 4 years from the date of signature mentioned on the cover page of the present document.
- 4. This Recognition Certificate will be reviewed for the first time at least 6 months before the end date of its validity unless any significant changes (Step 18 of EMAD R refers) to the Authorities occur before that date.
- 5. MAA NLD undertakes to inform DSAÉ immediately of any significant changes in accordance with Step 18 of EMAD R.
- 6. MAA NLD undertakes to supply approval certificates, audit reports*, supporting documents*, findings* and subsequent closure actions* to DSAÉ ideally in English for all initial approvals and on-going surveillance activities for approvals, accepted/to be accepted by DSAÉ. (* with the agreement of the audited entity concerned)
- 7. MAA NLD undertakes to inform DSAÉ in a timely manner of any concerns they may have relating to the performance of a maintenance or training organization, the approvals of which have been adopted by DSAÉ.
- 8. The essential principle that recognition is a national responsibility is maintained, hence sovereign regulatory responsibility is not abdicated by issuance of this certificate.
- The Recognition Partners' signatories below are duly authorised to make the agreements given above and do so in light of the EDA Steering Board decision dated 10 Nov 2008 in Ministerial formation.
