- 1. Recognition, in this case, is of an Authority by another Authority. To achieve the goal of regulating once and using the outcome many times, the recognition process guidelines detailed in EMAD R have been followed and confidence has been gained that MAA of Switzerland's airworthiness assurance and regulatory approach is acceptable to DSAÉ.
- 2. MAA of Switzerland's conduct of regulatory assurance is assessed as being at a standard by which the continuing airworthiness artefacts and collaborative oversight can be accepted by DSAÉ as described in the table here below.

Approvals of maintenance or training organisations, and military aviation maintenance licences delivered by MAA of Switzerland can be accepted by the DSAE.		
Audits and surveillance for the approvals of maintenance and training organisations may be conducted jointly.	Development of the process for conducting joint audits and surveillance is required.	

- 3. This Recognition Certificate is valid **4 years** from the date of signature mentioned on the cover page of the present document.
- 4. This Recognition Certificate will be reviewed for the first time at least 6 months before the end date of its validity unless any significant changes (Step 18 of EMAD R refers) to the Authorities occurs before that date.
- **5. MAA of Switzerland** undertakes to inform **DSAÉ** immediately of any significant changes in accordance with Step 18 of EMAD R.
- 6. Upon request MAA of Switzerland undertakes to supply approval certificates, audit reports (with the agreement of the auditee), supporting documents, findings and subsequent closure action to DSAÉ in English for all initial approvals and on-going surveillance activity for approvals, accepted/to be accepted by DSAÉ.
- 7. MAA of Switzerland undertakes to inform DSAÉ in a timely manner of any concerns they may have relating to the performance of a maintenance or training organization, the approvals of which has been adopted by DSAÉ.
- 8. The essential principle that recognition is a national responsibility is maintained, hence sovereign regulatory responsibility is not abdicated by issuance of this certificate.
- 9. The Recognition Partners' signatories below are duly authorised to make the agreements given above and do so in light of the EDA Steering Board decision dated 10 Nov 2008 in Ministerial formation.
