- 3. This Recognition Certificate is valid **4 years** from the date of signature mentioned on the cover page of the present document.
- 4. This Recognition Certificate will be reviewed for the first time at least 6 months before the end date of its validity unless any significant changes (Step 18 of EMAD R refers) to the Authorities occurs before that date.
- **5. NMAA**'s undertakes to inform **DSAÉ** immediately of any significant changes in accordance with Step 18 of EMAD R.
- 6. NMAA's undertakes to supply approval certificates, audit reports*, supporting documents*, findings* and subsequent closure action* to DSAÉ ideally in English for all initial approvals and on-going surveillance activity for approvals, accepted/to be accepted by DSAÉ. (* with the agreement of the audited entity concerned)
- **7. NMAA**'s undertakes to inform **DSAÉ** in a timely manner of any concerns they may have relating to the performance of a maintenance or training organization, the approvals of which has been adopted by **DSAÉ**.
- 8. The essential principle that recognition is a national responsibility is maintained, hence sovereign regulatory responsibility is not abdicated by issuance of this certificate.
- 9. The Recognition Partners' signatories below are duly authorised to make the agreements given above and do so in light of the EDA Steering Board decision dated 10 Nov 2008 in Ministerial formation.
