Pursuant to United States Department of Defense Directive 5030.61, DoD Airworthiness Policy, and subject to the conditions specified below, the United States Navy Director for Airworthiness, on behalf of the Airworthiness Authorities of the United States Army, the United States Navy, and the United States Air Force, formally recognizes the

Military Airworthiness Authorities of France (DGA and DSAÉ)

as competent Military Airworthiness Authorities which establish, maintain, execute, and audit an airworthiness regulatory framework and function that offers appropriate processes for managing airworthiness of aircraft under their authority.

Conditions: This Tier 1 Recognition remains valid for a period of four (4) years while:

1. The French MAAs maintain a program of continued surveillance and internal quality monitoring.
2. The French MAAs remain compliant with all current laws, regulations, and processes as identified in the Military Authorities Recognition Questionset.
3. The French MAAs notify the USN/USMC Airworthiness Office of any significant changes in their airworthiness regulations, processes, or procedures.
