Conditions of Military Airworthiness Authority Recognition for French Military Airworthiness Authority (French MAA):

1. The Malaysian Directorate General Technical Airworthiness (**DGTA**) sovereign authorities and responsibilities are not abdicated by this recognition.
2. The **French MAA** comprises of the following organisations:
 - a. Direction de la Sécurité Aéronautique d'État (DSAÉ, State Aeronautical Safety Directorate).
 - b. Direction Générale de l'Armement (DGA, Directorate-General of Armament).
3. The **French MAA** is hereby recognized by the **DGTA** as a competent airworthiness authority that applies appropriate safety oversight for:
 - a. Initial Airworthiness.
 - (1) EMAR / FRA 21 J - Design.
 - (2) EMAR / FRA 21 G - Production.
 - b. Continuing Airworthiness.
 - (1) EMAR / FRA M - Continuing Airworthiness Management Organisation (CAMO).
 - (2) EMAR / FRA 145 - Approved Maintenance Organisation (AMO).
 - (3) EMAR / FRA 147 - Approved Maintenance Training Organisation (AMTO).
 - (4) EMAR / FRA 66 - Technician License.
4. Where practicable, **French MAA** will inform **DGTA** of significant changes to airworthiness organisation, regulations or procedures.
5. Where release is permissible, **French MAA** will inform **DGTA** of:
 - a. Significant aircraft accidents or incidents involving systems common to the Malaysian and French States, and for relevant safety information to be shared.
 - b. Significant safety or quality concerns arising from the performance of any approved organisations which may be providing services or products to the Malaysian State aviation.
6. The validity recognition of **French MAA** is in effect for four years from the date of this certificate unless amended, suspended or revoked. A review of the recognition shall be carried out prior to expiration and will be renewed if the review is successful.
